Assalamu Alaikum w.w.,

Respected Parents /Guardians,

We are writing to inform you that a child in your daughter's year group had tested positive for COVID.

As your daughter is part of the bubble, in line with advice received your child must immediately self-isolate at home for 14 days and follow this guidance:

<https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stay-at-home-guidance>. Your child must not return to school until she has completed this 14 day period of isolation. Your daughter may return to school on Monday 2nd November 2020 (after half term holidays).

We will inform you if this changes.

There is no requirement for other members of your household to self-isolate, unless anyone else in your household starts to develop symptoms.

For most people COVID 19 will be a mild illness. If your child does become unwell with a new, continuous cough or a high temperature, or has a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell, you must arrange for her to have a test to see if she has COVID 19. You can book a test at a local site or order a home test kit on the NHS website or contact 119 via telephone if you do not have the internet. If anyone else in your household starts to develop symptoms they must also have this test.

You must inform the school of any positive results.

Alhamdulillah.. the school remains safe and open. All other pupils will continue to come in to school as normal.

Your daughter should continue her learning through Google Classrooms. Subject to staff availability, lessons will be taught live following their school timetable. Please also check for classwork uploaded.
