Introduction

1. Islamiyah promotes excellence in everything its pupils undertake. The uniform of our pupils will support the ethos of our school; providing the pupils with pride to be part of the school thus enabling them to act as ambassadors for the school.
2. High standards of presentation are required at all times when wearing the school uniform. Whenever the school uniform is worn, it must be complete and not mixed with non-uniform clothing. This includes when travelling to and from school.

Aims

3. To set out the school's guidance for uniform.
4. To support the mission, vision and values of the Trust and its establishments.

Uniform guide

5. Appendix 1 sets out the school uniform requirements. The items listed in Appendix 1 are compulsory for all pupils (unless otherwise indicated). Specified items should be purchased from the school. Other items can be bought at a variety of retailer stores.
6. A different dress code may be required for school events, such variations for all non-uniform events will be clearly specified and communicated to parents and pupils.
7. Students are permitted to wear navy, blue, or black coats as part of their school attire. However, it is important to note that any shiny materials, such as metallic or glossy fabrics, are not allowed.
8. Hoodies, bomber jackets, and leather jackets are also not permitted as part of the school's dress code

Personal appearance

9. No jewellery other than a wrist watch may be worn (unless otherwise agreed on grounds of faith).
10. Hair must be kept tidy. Extremes of length or style is not permitted. (Unless otherwise agreed on grounds of faith).
11. Long nails, nail varnish and make up is prohibited.

School bags/Pencil case

12. School bags, pencil cases, stationary bags must not display offensive or political images or slogans.

Banned Items

13. Mobile phones, MP3 players, tablets, laptops, computers and other electronic equipment must not be brought into school unless specifically authorised in writing by the head teacher.

Breaches of Uniform Code

14. Uniforms will be checked on a daily basis to ensure they conform to the policy and that pupils look smart and well presented. In the event that a pupil has the wrong uniform, the teacher or member of staff will challenge the pupil and instruct them to address the issue.
15. For significant and repeated breaches of the uniform rules, the matter will be referred to the DHT and the pupil may be sent home to address the concern before returning to school.
16. Any pupil who fails to wear the correct uniform, will be sanctioned. Pupils will be given a warning and thereafter an after school detention.
17. If a prohibited or offensive item (such as an offensive image or slogan on stationary) is bought into school, the item will be confiscated.

Years 9, 10 & 11 will be given an afterschool detention and regular breach of PE uniform code will result in parents being contacted to come for a meeting with DHT.
